### **Information from the Sectional Committee**

  - July 19-22, 2018 hosted by Canyons
  - December 13-16, 2018 hosted by Fullerton
- The Sectional Committee will be accepting bids for the 2019 Sectional meets until Saturday, April 14<sup>th</sup> at noon. An email was sent to the Senior Coaches Distribution list, and information was posted on the Pacific Swimming website.

### **Senior Swimming Budget Planning**

Two emails with links to the same survey were sent to senior coaches, who were asked to estimate their travel numbers for the 2018-2019 budget and to give feedback on the ASCA LSC Education program.

The following teams responded with estimated numbers: Albany Armada, BAC, San Mateo Bull Dog, Carson Tiger Sharks, CROW, DACA, Marin Pirates, Mendocino Coast, Neptune, North Bay, Osprey, PASA, PEAK, PLS, QSS, Reno, SCSC, Seaside Dolphins, SUNN, Swim South Bay, TERA, and Valley Splash. Those estimates were shared with Mary for budgeting.

The collective responses to the survey regarding the ASCA LSC Education program are attached. These were collected via Survey Monkey, so I am not able to personally follow up with those who responded.

Out of the 24 people who responded, 13 replied that they used the program this year while 11 replied that they did not use the program.

19 coaches said that they would use the program next year if it is offered, while 4 said that they would not.

### **Senior Swimming Meet Schedule- 2018-2019**

We still have a few senior meets without hosts for the 2018-2019 season. Many senior coaches have expressed the need for more senior meets, but we are having a difficult time filling our current schedule.
